Principal's Report:

Quick overview of survey results about vaccination status of student body. Jenny stated that our numbers are a little higher than the community for being vaccinated. Kelby asked about parents' inquiries into vaccination status of staff. Some parents have inquired about the percentage of staff vaccinated. Christina stated we have had two positive cases of students who contracted it at home. There has been no spread within the school. Kids have been doing a good job with masks and hand washing, they could do better at social distancing but they are working on it. Chicken olympics occurred at Silver Creek Falls. Full student body at 192 kids, things going along well so far.

Facilities updates: Fence parts are in but installation won't occur until mid October. One solar panel cracked due to the heat, covered by warranty. HVAC that broke a coolant ring during the heat, might be covered by warranty. Outside maintenance is going to be an ongoing expense. Continue to work on building next door, have asbestos testing that needs to be done.

New staff is fitting in well and doing a good job with the instructional part of the job as

well as being a part of HSCS culture. Next month is official project based learning training with High Tech High and will help to get everyone on board with HSCS teaching.
